Medications

Family Insurance Policy

This provides secondary coverage to the parent's primary health insurance for medical costs incurred from an accident at camp, paying only for costs not covered by the child's primary health insurance. It is understood these programs are fully supervised by qualified camp staff.

Liability Release: I give permission for the above-mentioned camper to engage in all camp activities, except as noted by me, and am fully aware of the inherent hazards and assume all risks of loss, damage or injury that may be sustained by him or her. Ponca Bible Camp has my permission to use photographs and videos of child named above taken during camp for promotion purposes. No names will ever be published. I also understand that unclaimed items left behind will be donated to charity two weeks after the end of my camper's session.

Medical Release: In the event of an emergency or that I cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the physician, clinic, or hospital selected by Ponca Bible Camp to give emergency medical or surgical treatment and routine non-surgical medical care. 2010 Ponca Bible Camp Camp Rules and Parent Information

The goal of PBC is to share the love of Jesus Christ, and challenge campers to a life honoring their Savior. The best way to start an incredible Christ-centered week of camp is to read and follow these important rules!

Dress Code - As an adventure Bible camp, campers should wear athletic shorts, t-shirts, athletic shoes and socks at all times. No need for expensive clothing. Modest clothing is required! Flip-flops not allowed during activities.

- "Short shorts" and tank-tops are Not allowed
- No underclothing should be revealed
- No sleepwear worn outside of cabin
- Swimsuits must be one-piece
- Clothing shall be free from offensive printing
- Shoes and shirts are required at all times

What to Bring - Bible, notebook, pen, sleeping bag or blanket, sheets, pillow, towels, personal toiletry items, swimsuit, water shoes for river (optional), athletic clothes and shoes for sports, games, hiking and everyday wear, old clothes for caving, light jacket, flashlight, and extra money for snacks, stamps and souvenirs.

Prohibited Items - *NO Electronic devices allowed at camp!* Please, Do NOT bring: Cell phones, Ipods, CD players, CDs, electronic games, etc. There is no cell phone service at or near the camp. Please bring actual alarm clocks, campers will not be allowed to have cell phones for this purpose. Do Not bring food to camp, campers are not allowed to have food in their cabins in effort to keep away rodents and animals. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illegal drugs, fireworks, knives, weapons and inappropriate reading material are prohibited and will be cause for possible dismissal. PBC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Medications - ALL Medications (prescription and over-the-counter) are turned in to the First-Aid Attendant at the start of camp. Label all medications and include administration/dosage instructions in a zip-lock bag.

Transportation - A bus from Whitewater, KS and Sedalia, MO will leave each Sunday morning for camp and return the following Saturday afternoon, except Week 6, which returns Friday. Arrive for the Kansas bus by 6:30a.m. for the Missouri bus by 9:00a.m. *Please bring cash for a McDonald's meal for both trips to and from camp. Mail/Contact - PBC is remote, please allow 4 days for postal delivery. Please do not mail food. Personal visits to camp are not recommended to be fair to all campers, keep camp schedules, and avoid home-sickness. Campers may only receive phone calls in case of an emergency. Ponca Bible Camp has only one phone line which rings in the kitchen, office, first-aid room and administrator's house. Please, No calls after 10:00 p.m.

Information for Parents

- In the case of an accident, PBC carries a limited accidental insurance policy, which is secondary coverage to the parent's insurance on their child. Parents will be contacted for non-emergency medical decisions.
- Please ensure your child has recently received a tetanus shot, the more recent, the better!
- Sorry, no laundry facilities available to campers.

On-line Registration Discount – Register On-line by May 15th, and receive \$25.00 off the registration fee.

Camp Staff Scholarship - Volunteer staff members earn a \$50.00 scholarship for each week of camp they work in the current season. Staff members may designate the scholarship to any camper attending the current camp season. *This does not apply to Jr. Counselors or Leadership Team Members, as they are in training programs.*

Church Sponsorship - Swiss Church in Whitewater, Kansas and Maplewood Church in Sedalia, Missouri have some sponsorships available for campers needing assistance with registration fees. If your child received a church sponsorship or Peggy White Memorial Scholarship, please indicate on the Fee Schedule.

Camp Registration - Whether registering by mail or on-line, a camper is registered once PBC receives both: 1) Completed Registration and 2) Entire Registration Fee. PBC will only contact you if there are questions about the registration or if your child is placed on a waiting list. Ponca Bible Camp serves approximately 75 kids per week. Some weeks fill up very quickly, so please send your registration in early!
